2019 Secondary School Sport SA 15 and under Event

(Under the auspices of and subject to the control of Golf Australia – SA)

Thursday 4th & Friday 5th July North Adelaide Golf Club

Played over 36 holes - 18 holes of stroke play each day

This event ensures a continuous pathway for students from primary school golf into their early secondary years.

Students Eligible

Students must be at least 13 years of age and not older than 15 years on Dec 31st 2019
Students will be categorized Metro or Country as to the school they attend per the SSSSA zoning
This event is open to both boys and girls with or without a GA handicap

Competition Components

Metro students will compete for the Metro Championship. (36hole event, 18 each day)
Country students will compete for the Country Championship. (36hole event, 18 each day)
All Students competing for the SSSSA 15 & under Championship (36hole event, 18 each day)

Participation event - Non Handicap Players

Students without an official GA Handicap are most welcome

May play on either day or both days

It is expected that all players will have their own equipment and some knowledge of golf which may have been gained through participating in school golf programs or by playing regularly with fellow golfers

15 and under representative team

A representative team for the 15 and under national championship will be determined at this event
Selection criteria - Metro & Country boy and girl gross and nett winners – 8 players

TERMS OF THE COMPETITION

- 1. Format – Individual Championship**
 - 1.1 Played over 36 holes, 18 holes stroke play each day.
 - 1.2 In the event of a tie, a sudden death hole by hole play-off will be conducted (as decided by the Match Committee). Ties for other place getters will be decided by countback.
 - 1.3 **Metro students** will compete for the Metro Championship. (36hole event, 18 each day)
Country students will compete for the Country Championship. (36hole event, 18 each day)
All Students competing for the SSSSA 15 & under Championship (36hole event, 18 each day)
Participation event - Non Handicap Players - Students without an official GA Handicap are most welcome to play on either day or both days. It is expected that all players will have their own equipment and some knowledge of golf which may have been gained through participating in school golf programs or by playing regularly with fellow golfers.
 - 2. Medals & Trophies**
 - 2.1 Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded to boys and girls placed 1st, 2nd & 3rd in both the Metro & Country Championships (36hole competition). Trophies will be awarded to boys and girls placed 1st, 2nd & 3rd in the State Championships (36hole competition). Prizes will also be awarded for the net handicap competition.
 - 3. Inclement Weather**
 - 3.1 Golf Australia & SSSSA weather policies apply. In the case of adverse conditions, the playing format may be modified or cancelled.
 - 4. Match Committee**
 - 4.1 The Match Committee will comprise the GA(SA) Match Committee.
 - 4.2 In the absence of the full Match Committee, such members as may be present at the time, may give a decision, and any decision so given will be deemed to be a decision of the full Match Committee.
 - 4.3 The Match Committee will have the sole management and control of the event, with full power at any time to alter or vary any one of the Conditions.
 - 4.4 The Match Committee's decision on matters affecting the event will be final.
 - 4.5 Any dispute or protest must be made to the Match Committee not more than 15 minutes after the conclusion of play on the day on which the disputed matter has arisen.
 - 5. Rules of Play**
 - 5.1 The Rules of Golf, as adopted by R & A Rules Limited, will apply together with Local Rules of the venue Club.
 - 6. Entries**
 - 6.1 Students must be at least 13 years of age and not older than 15 years on Dec 31st 2019. Students will be categorized Metro or Country as to the school they attend per the SSSSA zoning. This event is open to both boys and girls with or without a GA handicap
 - 6.2 The entry fee for the event is \$30.00 (including GST) and must be paid at the time of registration.
 - 6.3 Registrations must be made via the GA (SA) online registration system. Entries by any other method will not be accepted.
 - 6.4 Players must register by 5:00pm on Monday 24 June 2019. IT IS THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE ENTRANT THEMSELVES TO ENSURE THAT THEY HAVE REGISTERED CORRECTLY. A player has not officially registered until their name is listed in the 'Registered Participants' section of the event registration page.
 - 6.5 The decision of the Match Committee as to acceptance or refusal of any entry will be final.
 - 6.6 Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Match Committee.
 - 7. Conforming Golf Balls and Conforming Driver Heads**
 - 7.1 The specimen conditions in the Rules of Golf are in effect as regards Conforming Golf Balls and Conforming Driver Heads.
 - 8. Drug Testing**
 - 8.1 All competitors are subject to drug testing by the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Agency for banned substances as laid down in Golf Australia's Anti-Doping Policy. Any competitor infringing this policy, or refusing to take a test, will be disqualified and subject to any sanction(s) brought down by ASADA.
 - 9. Mobile Phones**
 - 9.1 Except in case of emergency, mobile phones must not be used to make or receive calls or messages when on the golf course.
 - 10. Pace of Play**
 - 10.1 Rule 5-6 will be strictly enforced. A player must not unreasonably delay play, either when playing a hole or between two holes.
 - 11. Caddies / Supervisors**
 - 11.1 Caddies are not permitted.
 - 11.2 Supervisors - Golf Australia may assign a group organizer if necessary. There is no requirement for teachers or parents to assist but if it is the individual school policy that a teacher or parent must accompany its students then they are most welcome (at the approval of the Golf Australia representative)
 - 12. Motorised Transport**
 - 12.1 Ride-on buggies will be permitted only on medical evidence and by permission of the venue club. Applications and approvals to be forwarded to Golf Australia – SA at time of registration. Caddies are not permitted to use ride on buggies.
 - 13. Code of Conduct**
 - 13.1 All entrants assent to be bound by Golf Australia Code of Conduct. A copy of the Code is available at www.golf.org.au
 - 14. Smoking**
 - 14.1 Players and caddies are prohibited from smoking cigarettes, cigars or the like (including e-cigarettes) during a stipulated round. See Golf Australia Code of Conduct.
 - 15. Measuring Devices**
 - 15.1 A player may obtain distance only information by use of a distance measuring device.
 - 16. Draw**
 - 16.1 Tee times will be available on the Golf Australia – SA website www.golf.org.au/golfsa from 5pm Thursday 27 June 2019.
 - 17. Photography**
 - 17.1 By entering the event, you agree to having your photo taken and potentially published on social media.
