## TERMS OF THE COMPETITION

### 1. Format

- 1.1 The event will be played over 54 holes of stroke play.
- 1.2 In the event of a tie for the Championship, unless the Match Committee determines otherwise, players in such a tie will continue play over such holes as the Match Committee will decide, in a sudden-death, hole-by-hole playoff until the winner is determined. Ties for other placegetters will be decided by countback.

### 2. Entries

- 2.1 Eligible male players for the Championship are amateurs whose GA Handicap or overseas equivalent does not exceed 16.0 strokes. Eligible female players for the Championship are amateurs whose GA Handicap or overseas equivalent does not exceed 28.0.
- 2.2 Entrants must be 55 years of age or over on the first day of the event.
- 2.3 The Entrance Fee for the event is \$90.00 (including GST) and must be paid at the time of entry.
- 2.4 Entries must be made via the online registration system. Entries by any other method will not be accepted
- 2.5 GA (SA) has the right to refuse the entry of any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal.
- 2.6 Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Match Committee.
- 2.7 Players must register by 5.00pm on Monday 26<sup>th</sup> August 2019. **IT IS THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE ENTRANT THEMSELVES TO ENSURE THAT THEY HAVE REGISTERED CORRECTLY.** A player has not officially registered until their name is listed in the registered Participants section of the event registration page.
- 2.8 Entrance fees will only be refunded in the case of a withdrawal being advised prior to the draw being made available.
- 2.9 GA (SA) reserves the right to determine the size of the field with a **maximum combined field size of 90 players**. The field must comprise a minimum number of 30 men and 30 women (registrations permitting). If a ballot is required, the higher handicap competitors as at the closing date of registrations will be eliminated first. Unsuccessful entrants will be informed without delay. Entrance fees will be refunded to competitors balloted out.

### 3. Match Committee

- 3.1 The Match Committee will comprise the GA (SA) Match Committee.
- 3.2 In the absence of the full Match Committee, such members as may be present at the time as selected from GA (SA), may give a decision, and any decision so given will be deemed to be a decision of the full Match Committee.
- 3.3 The Match Committee will have the sole management and control of the event, with full power at any time to alter or vary any one of the Conditions.
- 3.4 The Match Committee's decision on matters affecting the vent will be final.

- 3.5 Any dispute or protest must be made to the Match Committee not later than 15 minutes after the conclusion of play on the day on which the disputed matter has arisen.
- 3.6 The Match Committee may, in the event of bad weather or for any other reason, alter the format, venue, time or day of play.

### 4. Rules of Play

- 4.1 The Rules of Golf, as adopted by R & A Rules Limited, will apply together with the GA Hard Card and Local Rules of the venue Club.

### 5. Drug Testing

- 5.1 All competitors are subject to drug testing by the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Agency for banned substances as laid down in Golf Australia's Anti-Doping Policy. Any competitor infringing this policy, or refusing to take a test, will be disqualified and subject to any sanction(s) brought down by ASADA.

### 6. Mobile Phones

- 6.1 Except in case of emergency, mobile phones must not be used to make or receive calls or messages when on the golf course.

### 7. Motorised Transport

- 7.1 Ride-on buggies will be permitted only on medical evidence and by permission of the venue Club. Applications and approvals to be forwarded to Golf Australia - SA at time of registration. Caddies are not permitted to use ride-on buggies.

### 8. Smoking Policy

- 8.1 Players and caddies are prohibited from smoking during a stipulated round. (Note: In addition to the more traditional forms of smoking, this policy is also considered to cover vaping and the like, etc.) Details of sanctions for a breach of this policy are contained in GA's Code of Conduct.

### 9. Code of Conduct

- 9.1 All entrants assent to be bound by Golf Australia's Code of Conduct. A copy of the Code is available at [www.golf.org.au](http://www.golf.org.au)

### 10. Measuring Devices

- 10.1 A player may obtain distance only information by use of a distance-measuring device.

### 11. Draws

- 11.1 Competitors will be drawn in such manner as GA (SA) shall arrange. The Match Committee reserves the right to alter the draw without notice.
